

**Directions to the park north entrance, which includes the pavilion, bicycle trailhead, and horse trailhead.**

**13201 Progress Blvd., Alachua, Florida 32615**

- From Gainesville:  
Drive north on 441 (can be accessed from NW 43rd St). Turn left on Progress Blvd and drive 0.7 miles to the park entrance. Note that the road changes from pavement to gravel a quarter mile before the entrance.
- From Alachua:  
From I-75, exit onto 441S (exit 399) and drive 2.8 miles south (through the city of Alachua). Turn right on Progress Blvd and proceed as above.

**Directions to the park headquarters, which includes the CSO building.**

**12720 NW 109th Lane, Alachua, Florida 32615-6741**

- From Gainesville:  
Go north on CR 241 and just after the I-75 overpass, turn right on NW 109th Lane. Go 1.1 miles on NW 109th Lane to a break in a black 4 rail fence on the left (east) side of the road. At the official state park sign, turn left. Drive past a horse paddock and pole barn to the metal CSO building.
- From Alachua:  
Go south on CR 241 until just before the I-75 overpass. Turn left on NW 109th Lane and continue as above.

**Directions to the park south entrance, which includes the hiking trailhead.**

**11101 Millhopper Road, Gainesville, Florida 32653**

- From Gainesville:  
Go north on 43<sup>rd</sup> Street to 53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue/Milhopper Road. Turn left and take Millhopper Road (also known as CR 232) and drive west approximately five miles, and then turn left into the hiking trailhead parking area.
- From Alachua:  
Go south on CR 241 to Millhopper Road. Turn left and take Millhopper Road (also known as CR 232) and drive approximately 2.1 miles, and then turn right into the hiking trailhead parking area.
